Falconry Experiences offers an unparalleled adventure of Arabian falconry, opening a fascinating portal on an age-old tradition in the first dedicated sustainable falconry area located in the historical surroundings of the Burqu Nature Reserve.

The programme focuses on sustainability to provide alternative falconry solutions in a safe and managed environment.

FALCONRY & TRAINING ZONE

The designated area for falconry and training falcons is located in Ruwaished Department, in the heart of the north-eastern Badia of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan. It is part of Burqu Nature Reserve that extends over an area of 2,982 km².

It is 300 km from Queen Alia International Airport and about 225 km from Al Hadithah/ Al-Omari land border crossing.

This area provides an ideal environment and conditions for sustainable falconry due to its geographical characteristics using captive-bred houbara bustards as prey, which are released specifically for this purpose.

SUSTAINABLE FALCONRY

Falconry is an integral part of the Arab culture. As unregulated hunting has caused the global decline of houbara bustards, educating the falconer community is crucial in preserving not only an age-long tradition, but also its threatened prey and the ecosystem where it lives. Sustainable falconry is possible through regulated practice in designated areas, alleviating pressure from wild populations.
